Proz-sur-Arly

The village of Praz-sur-Arly is located at an altitude of 1,035 meters, in the Val d'Arly, between Megève and Flumet. It is bathed by the Arly river, upstream of its gorges and sees the Cassioz stream and Varins stream pass by.

Praz-sur-Arly in the Pays du Mont-Blanc is an ideal spot for your holidays. Nestled in the heart of the Savoyard Departments, with easy access, this authentic village offers very varied scenery. Come and discover the mountains and spectacular views of the Mont Blanc range.

Praz-sur-Arly has become famous for its hot air ballooning and its annual international "Montgolfiades". It is THE main spot for hot air ballooning in the mountains. Flying noiselessly past the Mont Blanc is, one has to say, an exceptional privilege!

Praz-sur-Arly is the French commune with the most AOC cheeses: six in all (4 AOC: Beaufort, Reblochon, Abondance and Chevrotin, 2 IGP: Tomme and Savoy Emmental). We still have many working farms where you can discover our past heritage.

The lake!

Discover a fabulous new swimming pool in Praz sur Arly, facing the Mont Charvin...

an exceptional site for a refreshing summer break! A swimming lake supervised by lifeguards with free access for all, isn't that just heaven? A lake created with two different swimming areas to satisfy all your desires!

<u>ZONE 1:</u> A supervised public swimming area with a surface area larger than an Olympic-size swimming pool! Graduated depths from 0.30cm to 2.50m to satisfy both young and older swimmers... fantastic!

<u>ZONE 2:</u> An area reserved for water sports activities, where you can enjoy our giant Aquaparc and paddles for hire. A large public beach beside the swimming area, ideal for sunbathing between swims! Life is great at Praz Lac Aventures!

Access to the swimming lake:

The main access to the swimming lake is from the Belles Leisure Park via a footbridge over the Arly River.

Thanks to a footpath created right around the lake, accessible to people with reduced mobility from Les Belles or the Cassioz road, users will be able to reach the beach and the reception building in which sanitary facilities, a lifeguard's room, a storage room, a snack bar and a reception office are planned. They will also be able to reach the Accrobranch tree climbing course on the banks of the Arly.

Only open in Summer.















Megève 3 minutes driving distance (5 km)

Located in the canton of Sallanches, in Haute-Savoie.

The town is well known as a ski resort near Mont Blanc in the French Alps. Conceived in the 1920s as a French alternative to St. Moritz by the Rothschilds, it was the first purpose-built resort in the Alps. Originally it was a prime destination for the French aristocracy; it remains one of the most famous and affluent ski resorts in the world.

Megève was created to symbolized the the French art of living.

Today, more than a ski resort, Megève is a warm and dynamic village all year round!

Between traditions, know-how, cultural activites and thrills explore this destination, rich from the past and at the forefront of its time!

Les Snisies

25 minutes driving distance (18 km)

Discover it in all its facets: the dynamic resort, the authentic mountain village of Hauteluce or the hamlet-station with panoramic views of Bisanne 1500... Everywhere you look you'll find the tradition of a simple, warm welcome.

Flumet

5 minutes walking distance (6 km)

Flumet, located in Savoie, 900 inhabitants, located at the altitude of 900 meters high on a rocky spur dominating the confluence of two mountain streams: the Arly and the Arrondine.

Notre-Dame-de-Bellecombe Environ & minites de route (7 km)

Notre-Dame-de-Bellecombe is located in Savoie. It's a family ski resort in Winter and in Summer. Once in Notre-Dame-de-Bellecombe, you will be able to discover their very nice mountain pastures!

In the village himself, you can still see some old farms and original cottages Its a very preserved village.







Saint-Gervais 20 minutes driving distance (16 km)

Saint-Gervais-les-Bains is located in Haute-Savoie. Thanks to the nature, Saint-Gervais is more than a ski resort! its an amazing 4 seasons destination!

Saint-Gervais Mont-Blanc - A source of natural well-being

Natural spring waters have irrigated the spa for more than 200 years. The hydrotherapeutic properties of the water here class Saint-Gervais as the only alpine spa resort in the Alps, one of 10 other spa towns in France.

The 19th Century spa architecture gives the town an antique-chic atmosphere, quite original in a ski resort!

The Thermal baths are open all year long, adults and children are welcome for an unforgettable moment of well-being!

More than 400km of ski slopes!

Saint-Gervais lies at the heart of the Evasion Mont- Blanc ski area offering 400 kilometres of slopes towards Megève, Combloux, Les Contamines Hauteluce and La Giettaz. The resort also benefits from 30 kms of slopes on the opposite side of town in Les Houches/Saint-Gervais, accessible by the Mont-Blanc Tramway, one of the oldest rack and pinion railways in the country.

What to do in Chamonix? Where to start ... Aiguille du Midi cable car

In just 20 minutes, the Aiguille du Midi cable car will take you from the centre of Chamonix to the high mountains, reaching an altitude of 3,842 m.

From the top of its 3777m, the Aiguille du Midi and its terraces offer a 360° view of the French, Swiss and Italian Alps. Thanks to an elevator, you can access the summit terrace at 3842m, to discover a breathtaking view of the Mont Blanc.

La Mer de Glace and the Montenvers' train

Hop on the famous rack-and-pinion railway, which takes passengers from Chamonix to the tourist site of Montenvers at an altitude of 1,913 m. Enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of the Mer de Glace glacier, the Drus and the Grands Jorasses.

Tramway du Mont-Blanc depuis Saint-Gervais

Discover a variety of alpines landscapes along the journey and some of the most views from the top. The highest cockwheel train in France awaits you for a marvellous trip to the foot of Mont-Blanc. Starting in Le Fayet or Saint-Gervais, after a trip through forests and alpine prairies, skiers and hikers may access the Bellevue Plateau and the Le Prarion ski area at the heart of an exceptional panorama (panoramic view of the Bionnassay glacier).

Le Grand-Bornand About 45 minutes drive (39 km)

The commune is located between the massif des Bornes and the Aravis mountain range.

In the heart of a splendid scenery, Le Grand-Bornand has preserved its soul of mountain village of Haute-Savoie while developing a tourist reception of quality.

The resort of Le Grand Bornand extends over two altitudes:

- at 1000 meters, is Le Grand-Bornand Village, a typical Savoyard village with its granary, its square, its church and its shops...
- 6 kilometers higher, on the road to the Col de la Colombière, lies Le Grand-Bornand Chinaillon, at an altitude of 1,300 meters, the main departure point for the downhill ski slopes.

La Clusaz About 50 minutes drive (41 km)

La Clusaz is located 27 km of Annecy, at the foot of the Aravis massif and the Aravis pass.

30 minutes from Annecy, this beautiful village of 1700 inhabitants is one of the few resorts that offer a beautiful alpine domain and a beautiful Nordic domain. At the foot of the Aravis range, it spreads its beautiful wooden chalets covered with tavaillons (small wooden tiles) on the sides of soft mountains.

You can also enjoy: dog sledding, paragliding, sledding, ice bumpers, skating rink and of course, the Aravis water park.


In Summer
